## There are changes to the Local Rules concerning the boundaries for Hazards viz

- . The Oil-lines will not be renewed and will eventually grow out;
- . Red Stakes around water indicate the presence of the Hazard but do not define the Boundary;
- . Where the Fairway/Rough breaks down (eg into an embankment), this now defines the beginning of the Hazard where penalty and drops come into play;
- . If there is no water in a defined Hazard (as on LHS of 14th), then the existing red pegs define the Hazard.
- . Members are encouraged to download the free R&A Rules of Golf App and familiarise themselves with procedures for Penalty Areas.
